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1. Introduction

Amesci is committed as a partner in the project «RESMYLE - *Repenser emploi et insertion sociale des jeunes méditerranéens à travers le développement durable*» funded by the Program ENI CBCMED 2014-2020.

The RESMYLE project is based on two simultaneous observations:

1. The difficulties of professional integration of young people in the Mediterranean are increasing in all countries, in particular for the less qualified.
2. However, the challenges of environmental protection in the Mediterranean bring to light on the territories many new needs, potentially creating jobs: energy efficiency, space maintenance, waste reduction, eco-mobility, prevention of risks, etc.

The project brings together 9 Mediterranean partners (companies, associations, universities) in 5 countries (France, Italy, Jordan, Lebanon, Tunisia) around 3 areas of intervention:

1. Support youth integration organizations in the Mediterranean (training center, associations, social centers) to help them take better account of sustainable development in their actions. The planned achievements are a resource center and training tools for educators and social workers.
2. Develop a network of training workshops for young Mediterranean people, focused on sustainable development: spatial planning, risk prevention, sustainable consumption, etc. The objective is to train young Mediterranean people in sustainable development through concrete field training in Mediterranean territories, thereby promoting their experience and their professional integration. The planned achievements are 16 training courses tested with more than 200 young people, i.e. a catalogue of 32 weeks practical training.
3. Create a Mediterranean network of eco-incubators for businesses and projects led by young people based on a common method and shared tutoring / training offers.

The planned achievements are 6 incubators in 5 countries, 15 training courses for young business creators, 60 supported youth projects.

The project officially started on 2019 August 31st, and ended on 2022 August 30th.

2. Object of the contract

The notice relates to the outsourcing of the insurance coverage service for 24 young volunteers aged between 18 and 29 engaged in volunteer missions lasting 3 months to be carried out in Lebanon, Jordan, France, Tunisia and Italy, with the following distribution:

- 3 volunteers in Lebanon
- 3 volunteers in Jordan
- 6 volunteers in France
- 6 volunteers in Tunisia
- 6 volunteers in Italy

The insurance must include:

Abroad

- Medical expenses coverage (from illness to injury)
- Injuries and death
- Repatriation in case of need
- Hospitalization from illness and convalescence (including covid-19)
- Third party liability.

Italy

- Medical expenses coverage (from illness to injury)
- Injuries and death
- Repatriation in case of need
- Third party liability.

3. Terms of reference

This call for tender is addressed to insurance companies and / or intermediaries or to all those who can propose solutions that meet the requirements of the call.

4. Duration

Each volunteer mission has a duration of 3 months.

5. Formalization of service providers' proposals

Suppliers must submit their offer (a detailed cost estimate with reference to the type of coverage) by e-mail.

6. Deadline for sending applications

The proposals must be sent by e-mail to internazionale@amesci.org specifying in the subject " Call for tender for Insurance service - RESMYLE project", by 3:00 pm CET of 24th February 2022.

7. Evaluation of applications and notification of results

Applications received by the deadline indicated in previous point 6 will be evaluated according to the most economically advantageous offer in compliance with the provisions of previous point 2. Notification of results will take place by 25th February 2022 by e-mail.

8. Commitments and responsibilities

The contracting authority undertakes to pay the amounts due within 24 hours of signing the contract, which will take place by February 28, 2022.

The successful bidder undertakes to issue the policy within 24 hours of signing the contract and in any case no later than 1 March 2022.
