### WORK

The aim of the project is to help develop, organize and direct the RESMYLE International Training Workshop held in Napoli in Spring 2022. You will be part of the staff of the event and will help in any way you can, from communications to logistics to linguistic mediation with the French and Arabic speaking participants. You will learn how to cooperate with other volunteers, be at the side of the workshop coordinator as his assistant and support him in his tasks in the making of an international event centered around sustainability and ethical development. Some of the acquired skills will be: how to organize a schedule of the activities and make sure it is respected, how to check in and out the training participants of the workshop and be a support and a guide for them in their experience, how to implement creative solutions for problems and how to manage an international cultural and artistic event with guests such as artists, musicians, dancers and specialists. Working hours will be up to you to manage together with the coordinator of the event according to the tasks we will encounter.

Once the workshop is over you will help in the capitalization phase of the workshop as well as help the hosting association in their daily duties, such as social agriculture at the side of children on the autistic spectrum.

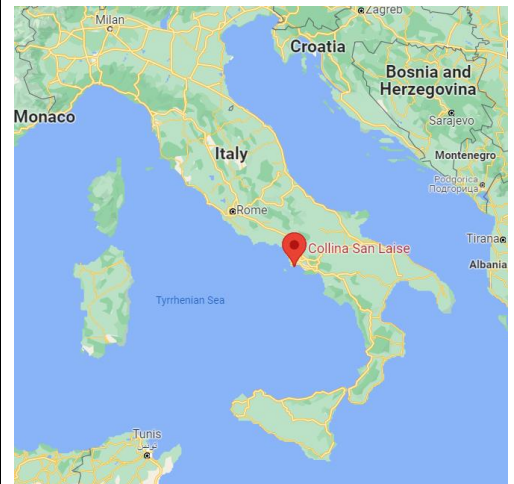




## LOCATION

Collina San Laise, in Bagnoli, suburb of the city of Napoli, is easily reachable by car or public transportation and immersed in green. Collina San Laise is a hill on the seaside of Napoli that has been requalified by Autism Aid Onlus and is location of a social agriculture plan inclusive of young people on the autistic spectrum, as well as many other cultural and social activities.

Collina San Laise is about half an hour away from the centre of Napoli, a beautiful ancient port city in the South of Italy, home to many touristic attractions both in and out the metropolitan area, such as the many monuments of the old town, the National Archeological Museum of Napoli, Pompeii, and many more. It is a city of arts and culture as well as a popular destination for students, hosting important universities renowned in all of Europe, as well as a naturalistic paradise, with its wonderful coasts and the Vesuvius, a mighty volcano just a few steps away with many natural paths to walk and explore.

1) Fill in the digital Passenger Locator Form (dPLF). To fill in the dPLF it is necessary:

- 2) be negative on the rapid molecular or antigen test within the past 72 hours
  - 3) 10-day fiduciary isolation at the address indicated in the Passenger Locator Form and molecular or antigen test at the end of this period

You will arrive in the Napoli International Airport, which is about 20 minutes away by car or public transportation from the center of Napoli. From there, we will be happy to pick you up and take you to the family that will host you for this time we'll spend together. Our headquarters for the planning phase will be in Via Mezzocannone, in the very center of the old town of Napoli, while the venue of our workshop will be slightly out of the center, by the seaside, and nearby your accommodation. Public transportation is very intuitive and you can easily buy the tickets in the train stations whenever you need to, we'll explain to you how to move around and will gladly take you on a tour as soon as you get here so that you start familiarizing with the place.
