The Cultural Association l'Agorà was born in Dugenta, a small town in Sannio (Benevento), in 2006 from the idea of a group of young people united by the desire to create aggregation, promote the dissemination of culture, reach out to the most disadvantaged, promote the active participation of the citizen in civil society.

The choice of the name is not accidental. The agora: the square, which has always welcomed, aggregates, stimulates, creates tensions and relationships, sometimes "revolutions".



It is a non-profit association, and the main areas of intervention are:

- peace, integration, welcome, solidarity, human rights
- Sustainable Development
- street art and photography
- protection and enhancement of the territory

Mission:

- create aggregation especially through art, music, photography and sport
- reach out to the most fragile and the most vulnerable
- promote the values of volunteering and active citizenship
- write pages of the future together, for a better, more supportive, fairer, more just and more humane world and for a more livable planet.

WORK

Volunteers will be involved in numerous non-formal activities, with the aim of promoting and fostering social inclusion, active citizenship, environmental education, especially through street art. The project aims, on the one hand, to achieve skills in the arts and crafts, through stencil and screen printing workshops, as well as through the design and creation of murals and artistic installations, on the other hand to focus attention on education for sustainable development as it does not only concern the environment, but also the economic sphere (consumption, poverty, north and south of the world) and society (rights, peace, health, inclusion, cultural diversity). Focusing on education for sustainable development means touching many aspects of life and the common values of equity and respect for others, for future generations, for diversity, for the environment, for the earth's resources.

The activities will also be carried out with the support of volunteers of the Italian civic service.

Camping weekends are planned, volunteers will be given the opportunity to camp in a green space on the slopes of Monte Mutria in the heart of the Matese Regional Park and the Titerno mountain community and to be able to taste products at km 0 for free.

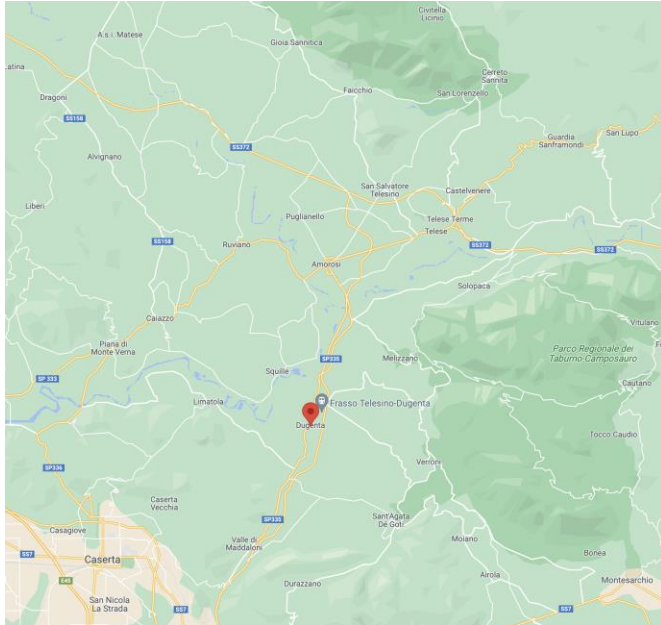
OUTPUT

- campaigns to promote the culture of social inclusion and sustainable development also through stencil and screen printing workshops entrusted among others to the Gambian artist NURU B, born Muhammed Ceesay, a very young asylum seeker who arrived in Italy while still a minor in 2016;
- regeneration of spaces, even abandoned and / or degraded, through the construction of n. 2 murals, directed by the Campania street artist Biodpi aka Fabio Della Ratta.

The activities will take place mainly in the morning, for 5 hours a day and for 5 days a week.







LOCATION

The project will be carried out mainly in Dugenta, in the province of Benevento and in some municipalities of particular historical interest in the Benevento Sannio, such as Sant'Agata de 'Goti, Cerreto Sannita, Teleso Terme and Cusano Mutri.

The municipal territory of Dugenta, lying along the valley of the Volturno river, is surrounded by hills rich in vegetation and is located near Mount Taburno.

It is about 45 km from the capital Benevento, about 50 km from Naples, 20 km from Caserta.

The railway station called "Frasso Telesino - Dugenta", located on the Naples - Foggia line, is located in the territory of the Municipality of Dugenta. The station is served by some regional trains operated by Trenitalia from and to Benevento, from and to Caserta and from and to Napoli Centrale.

Well connected also thanks to the buses; you can easily reach the Neapolitan capital as there are 3 trips a day, round trip, on the buses of the Pietraraja - Teleso - Naples route.

The town has a predominantly agricultural vocation.

Sannio Falanghina and Aglianico wines, oil, annurche apples, mozzarella D.O.P. are produced here.

It is part of the National Association of Wine Cities.

 - health needs
 - study needs
 - return to your home or residence

 - follow the guided procedure to access the dPLF
 - choose Italy as destination country

 - fill in and send the dPLF following the guided procedure Once the form has been sent, the passenger will receive the dPLF in pdf and QRcode format at the e-mail address indicated during registration, which must be shown directly from his smartphone upon boarding.  - 2) be negative on the rapid molecular or antigen test within the past 72 hours
 - 3) 10-day fiduciary isolation at the address indicated in the Passenger Locator Form and molecular or antigen test at the end of this period

If the volunteer intends to reach Dugenta independently, from Naples he can take the train to Benevento and get off at the station "Frasso Telesino – Dugenta". Tickets can be purchased at the station ticket offices or at the tobacconist's or on line
